

A temporary Road closure has been put in place to allow Fibrus to carry out utility works which are expected to commence 12th February 2024 and anticipated to take 3 days to complete.

Location: Red Beck Road, Cleator Moor From its junction with Frizington Road, extending in a north easterly direction for approx.2.6km.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted section of Red Beck Road, U4026, A5086, Main 8Street and Parkside Road and a way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times
