2. Completed nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer at The Copeland Centre, Catherine Street, Whitehaven, CA28 7SJ, between the hours of 10am and 4pm on any working day after the date of publication of this notice but no later than 4pm on Wednesday, 3rd April 2019.
3. If the election is contested, the poll will take place on Thursday, 2nd May 2019.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Friday, 12th April 2019. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments to or cancellations of postal proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Copeland Centre, Catherine Street, Whitehaven, CA28 7SJ by 5pm on Monday, 15th April 2019.
6. New applications to vote by proxy must be received by the Electoral Registration Officer at The Copeland Centre, Catherine Street, Whitehaven, CA28 7SJ by 5pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2019.
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or employment/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Copeland Centre, Catherine Street, Whitehaven, CA28 7SJ by 5pm on Thursday, 2nd May 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday, 24th April 2019.
